## MANAGEMENT & INNOVATION CONCENTRATION

The Management & Innovation Concentration is a broad and flexible concentration that seeks to afford students the skills necessary to address a collection of complex management and leadership issues facing the world's managers today. Students in this concentration will focus on issues surrounding human and resource management, communications, operations, ethics and corporate social responsibility while also learning management innovation tools such as total quality management, reengineering, benchmarking, strategic planning, electronic communication and commerce, performance management, and team management.

The Management & Innovation Concentration primarily serves working professional students from the for-profit, nonprofit, social enterprise and government sectors in the greater New York City area, but also from countries across the globe. The Concentration provides the knowledge and skills necessary to advance into more senior management positions to lead large organizations or to serve as founders and team leaders in smaller organizations or startups.

In addition to the EMPA Core, students must take four of the seven courses (12 credits total) listed below to complete the Management & Innovation Concentration. This structure offers our students the flexibility to pursue the skills most relevant to their career, while also gaining from the rigorous EMPA core.
